Pack Information

- Pack 119 is 36 years old
- Chartered by Riley School PTO
- Quality Unit
- 21 Registered Adult Leaders
- Approximately 46 Registered Scouts
 - 6 Tiger Cubs Scouts (1st grade)
 - 21 Cub Scouts (2nd and 3rd grade)
 - 18 Webelos Scouts (4th and 5th grade)
- 1 Den Chief
- Volunteers make the Pack go! *Every family takes on a Pack job*

Program Highlights

- Den meetings 1-2 times per month for Tiger Cubs; 2-4 times per month for Cub Scouts and Webelos Scouts
- Pack Night every month (usually on a Friday night at Riley School) – *Family event*
 - Awards and recognition
 - Some months entertainment
 - Always fun
- Monthly Pack outings – *Family event*
- Pinewood Derby in January – *Family event*
- Blue and Gold Banquet in February (anniversary of Cub Scouting) – *Family event*
- Pack Campouts in winter and spring – *Family events*
- Cub Scout Summer Camps (“OUTING” is three quarters of “SCOUTING”)
- Year-round program

Cost/Funding

- \$35 registration fee – registration with BSA and subscription to Boys’ Life
- Pack 119 has one fund raiser per year...popcorn
 - Each Scout is expected to sell popcorn to family and friends as well as participate in store-front sales
 - Funds collected are put in Pack’s general fund
 - Scouts earn prizes based on individual sales
- The Pack’s general fund generally pays for Scouts’ activities/awards throughout the year. Parents and sibling generally pay their own way.
- Dens may have dues to cover costs of project material/snacks, etc.
- There is a handbook for each rank in Cub Scouts (can be purchased at Scout Shop)

Uniform (as required by Pack 119)

Purchase uniform at Scout Shop

- Blue uniform shirt for Tiger Cubs and Cub Scouts
- Tan uniform shirt for Webelos Scouts
 - American Flag patch (if not attached already)
 - World Crest patch
 - Northwest Suburban Council patch
 - Pack 119 numerals
 - Den patch

- Recommended but not required by Pack 119
 - Official Cub Scout belt (*Scouts can earn belt loop awards which fit perfectly on official belt*)
 - Red “brag” vest (*many awards do not go on the uniform, the brag vest is a good place to collect and show-off these badges*)
- Other items available but not required by Pack 119
 - Official Cub Scout pants
 - Official Cub Scout socks
 - Hat (one for each rank)
